<u>SCHOOL SUPPLY FEE:</u> Reminder the \$80 school supply fee is due. This fee also includes your homework book fee for those classes using homework books. You can pay by cash, cheque or e-transfer.

<u>PARKING LOT PROCEDURES</u>: Please read thoroughly. These rules are in place to keep everyone safe and for traffic to flow efficiently. If you have any questions contact the school office. There will be a staff member directing traffic the first day of school

- All traffic is to enter single file via First Avenue and exit via Broadway Avenue. Please drive slowly
- Vehicles are NOT to be parked along the school building from the double doors to the end of the pavement. This is drop off only.
- If a parent needs to get out of the vehicle for any reason, the vehicle must be parked in the designated parking area beyond the crosswalk.
- Vehicles parked by the rectory are to have their headlights facing the school. (back in) Continued on the next page....

- No parking across from the Bus drop off for the whole block. This is a posted no parking area.
- No parking or dropping students off using the Bus lane along Manitoba Street.
- Vehicles may park along the wooden fence, but must back in
- Vehicles are to stop for pedestrians and cyclists. There is a stop sign at the crosswalk.

Cyclists and pedestrians are to cross the parking lot at the crosswalk. All must walk.

- Crosswalks are to be used to reach parked vehicles.
- No playing in the parking lot.
- Do not block any of the driveways on Broadway Avenue.
- Do not park in front of the shed, dumpsters or use the driveway in front of Pre K.
