Call for Accessibility Committee Members

The BC Ministry of Education & Childcare passed the Accessible British Columbia Act, S.B.C. 2021, c. 19 that provides strategies for BC Schools to become more accessible. CISPG has developed an [initial plan](#) and all 8 schools have completed their review of school facilities and drafted 2-3 priorities as a starting point in a three year plan.

CISPG invites applicants to join the CISPG Accessibility Committee by completing the [application form](#). Please submit the form to CISPG at cis@cispg.ca by Friday December 5th, 2025.

The committee will follow the structure outlined in the Accessible British Columbia Act. To the extent possible, half the committee will include:

- People with disabilities, and/or
- People with children or youth with current or emergent considerations related to disability and accessibility, and/or
- People who work or volunteer at a CISPG School, and/or
- People or organizations that support people with disabilities.

The committee will represent the different backgrounds and experiences of community members with children / youth.

The committee will follow the principle of “nothing about us without us”.

The committee's scope of work will include:

- Providing input into the development of an accessibility plan based on the principles of Inclusion, Adaptability, Diversity, Collaboration, Self-Determination, and Universal Design.
- Providing input into any school's barriers to accessibility such as attitudinal, physical, sensory, information and communication, systemic, and technology issues.
- Reviewing feedback from the CISPG Accessibility Feedback Tool.
- Advising the Superintendent on the school's accessibility plan.

The committee will schedule afterschool meetings beginning in February 2026. Tentatively, there will be three to four meetings a year. 
